Pregnancy Pathway Program of Greater Cincinnati

Pregnancy Pathway program is dedicated to helping pregnant women get prenatal care. The purpose of the program is to make sure moms will have healthy pregnancies and reduce the chance of premature deliveries or low birthweight babies.

Who is Eligible for Pregnancy Pathway Services?

Pregnant women who live in Hamilton County, and meet certain income guidelines are eligible to enroll with the Pregnancy Pathway program.



What can Pregnancy Pathway Providers do for me?

The Pathway providers will connect you with a Community Health Worker or Nurse who will:

- Help you schedule appointments
- Assist you in keeping your regular doctors' appointments for prenatal care
- Work with you to learn better ways of taking care of yourself and your children during your pregnancy
- Refer you to services that can help with the barriers you may be experiencing, such as:
 - Transportation
 - Housing
 - Drug/Alcohol Addiction
 - Emotional Support
 - Food
